

Sea Kayaking with the Whales : Campobello Island Sept 12, 13, and 14

Sea Kayak where whales migrate passing between two nations, Canada and the United States. We'll spend our days exploring the dynamic coastline of Campobello Island, stepping back in time among the surrounding islands where the art of weir fishing is still practiced and where 20 foot tides expose a unique intertidal zone and produce amazing currents. Whales follow the flow of food through the "feeding grounds" as the locals call it, just off the beautiful Campobello Lighthouse. We'll take time to visit Roosevelt's Estate and gardens by bicycle along the quiet roadways through the island.

Three nights Lodging in a Cabin on the coast



Day one: Arrive about 12pm, enjoy lunch, settle into cabin, spend afternoon paddling to the lighthouse from the harbor. (L, D)

Day Two: After breakfast we'll launch and paddle to the outer islands and through the "feeding grounds" in search of whales and porpoise, with lunch on a remote island. Relax over dinner in the evening and admire the stars in the amazingly dark evening sky. (B, L, D)

Day Three: Spend the morning kayaking and the afternoon biking and visiting the Roosevelt estate. Bikes available for rent. (\$15 per day)
Depart in morning day four

Prices, Terms and Agreements for Private Charter:

Minimum Participants or Cost of 6 pp

Price per person: \$525

Prices include: Three nights **double occupancy** in cabin rental, meals and beverages from lunch day 1 through dinner day 3, guide and kayaking gear.
